Hazard	People at risk	Action taken
DBS Checks	Client, Visitors	Regular DBS checks completed. Certificate available online
Injury while lifting, carrying, or setting up equipment	Service provider	Equipment carried in manageable amounts. Equipment lifted with correct posture. Trolley used where necessary.
Risk of strangulation with cables	Service provider, Client, Visitors	All cables to be covered with cable safety covers or secured in area visitors do not pass through
Slip or Trip hazards	Service provider, Client, Visitors	Equipment to be kept clear of pathways. Adequate space for equipment to be provided to Service provider by Client
Electric shock and fire	Service provider, Client, Visitors	Regular visual inspection performed by Service provider. Annual P.A.T. Testing Certificate obtained and available online. No liquids to be allowed near electrical equipment.
Injury from falling equipment	Service provider, Client, Visitors	Equipment to be set up only by Service provider, ensuring it is secure and using clamps when necessary. Adequate space provided between the disco/DJ equipment and Visitors
Injury due to noise	Service provider, Client, Visitors	Volume of equipment to be kept within a reasonable range.
Injury through dancing & games	Service provider, Client, Visitors	Client to provide basic first aid assistance in case of unintended collisions or falls.
Strobe lights causing sickness/seizures	Service provider, Client, Visitors	No strobes will be used. All disco lighting is used with pre programmed settings.
Allergies	Client, Visitors	Client is responsible for checking whether visitors have allergies and informing Service provider accordingly. Where the service provider supplies candy floss or Ketchup, any products used will have a full list of ingredients listed with original packaging available to view. Baby wipes provided by service provider are hypoallergenic with original packaging available to view.

Nerf Foam Dart Target Shooting: Risk Assessment		
Hazard	People at risk	Action taken
Being hit/shot by a foam Dart	Children, Staff & Visitors	Participants are briefed on safety instructions and rules before use. Participants only aim down the shooting range and are reminded to NEVER point a Nerf gun at another person. There is a clear firing line to ensure safety during use. Once participants have shot all of their darts, the nerf guns are placed down and reloaded by a member or staff.
Finger/skin trapped when loading rifle	Children, Staff & Visitors	The member of staff will offer to reload foam darts into the guns but demonstrations will be given with instructions on how to safely re-load the Nerf Gun with air pressure. The member off staff will offer assistance with any aspect when required. Users are reminded of rules and safety instruction throughout.
Standard of shooters	Children, Staff & Visitors	A member or staff will teach some basic aim & shooting drills throughout
Injuries to people outside the area of range	Children, Staff & Visitors	The Nerf Target Shooting range will be positioned with care to ensure no thoroughfare passes directly behind it. The rear of the set-up and air blower will be cordoned off with stands and hazard marked tape and / or chain to clearly mark 'no go' areas for the public. This area will also be used to store the equipment cases.
Unauthorised use	Children, Staff & Visitors	Nerf shooting range is always supervised. Loaded guns will only be handed to participants. Instructor to monitor the public do not remove barriers to access 'no go' areas.
Equipment failure / power failure	Children, Staff & Visitors	All equipment is checked regularly – before and after use. Any faulty equipment will removed from use until repaired. In the event of power failure the inflatable will slowly deflate within the safety area.
Slips & Trips	Children, Staff & Visitors	Waiting area checked and inspected before commencement of session. Children told not to run when moving around the range. All equipment except nerf guns is carefully positioned within a cordoned off area only accessible to staff. Staff member to be aware of the position of the designated first aider.
