

Ticketed Events Terms and Conditions

1. Definitions

1.1 The “Organiser” is DJ Dan Blaze of 138 Broughton Avenue, Aylesbury, Bucks, HP20 1PY.

1.2 These Terms and Conditions apply to all events organised by the Organiser (the “Event”).

1.3 “Standard” refers to full price general admission tickets.

Tickets

2. By purchasing, accepting, or using a ticket (a “Ticket”), the holder agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
3. Promotional offers apply to Standard tickets only and are offered at the Organiser’s discretion.
4. A valid Ticket entitles the holder to attend the Event on the stated date and time.
5. Unless otherwise stated:
 - Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult
 - A maximum of two children per adult is permitted
 - For adult-only events, no under 18s will be admitted
6. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry or admission to late arrivals. No refunds will be issued for late arrival.
7. Adults attending with children confirm they are the parent, legal guardian, or nominated guardian and are responsible for their supervision and behaviour.
8. Tickets are **non-refundable**, except in the circumstances outlined in the Refunds section below.
9. Tickets may be transferred to another person. The original purchaser remains responsible for the Ticket.
10. Tickets may be printed or shown on a mobile device for entry.
11. It is the Ticket holder’s responsibility to check all event details at the time of booking.
12. The Organiser reserves the right to make changes to the Event, including venue or programme. If the venue is changed to a significantly different location, customers may be entitled to a refund.
13. Tickets must not be used for promotional or competition purposes without prior written consent.
14. Essential companion tickets may be available at the Organiser’s discretion. Proof of eligibility may be required (e.g. DLA, PIP, Access Card, Blue Badge). Requests must be made at least 48 hours before the Event.
15. Tickets are sold in advance via the Organiser’s approved ticketing partner.
16. Entry will not be permitted without a valid Ticket.

Refunds and Cancellations

17. Tickets are non-refundable if the Ticket holder:
 - Cannot attend
 - Arrives late
 - Is refused entry
 - Is removed from the Event
 - Purchases the wrong Ticket
 18. If the Event is postponed, Tickets will remain valid for the new date.
If the Ticket holder cannot attend the new date, a refund may be requested.
 19. If the Event is cancelled by the Organiser, ticket holders will be entitled to a refund of the ticket price. Booking fees may be excluded.
 20. If the Event cannot go ahead due to circumstances beyond the Organiser's control, the Organiser will make reasonable efforts to reschedule the Event.
If rescheduling is not possible, a refund or credit will be offered.
 21. The Organiser is not responsible for any additional costs incurred by Ticket holders (e.g. travel, accommodation).
 22. Lost or stolen Tickets will not be replaced or refunded.

Entry and Conduct

23. Entry is subject to venue rules and security requirements.
 24. Valid ID may be required. Security decisions are final.
 25. Bag searches may be conducted as a condition of entry.
 26. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry or remove any person whose behaviour is deemed unsafe, disruptive, or inappropriate.
 27. No re-admission is guaranteed unless agreed by the Organiser.

Food, Drink and Alcohol

28. Venues operate a Challenge 25 policy.
 29. Attendees may bring reasonable quantities of food and drink for personal use.
Security may confiscate excessive amounts.

Safety and Liability

30. Attendees bring items at their own risk.
 31. Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, or for any other liability which cannot be excluded or limited by law.
 32. Loud music and lighting effects (including strobe lighting) may be used.
 33. Prohibited items include fireworks, sparklers, and animals (except assistance dogs).

Media

34. By attending, Ticket holders consent to being photographed, filmed, or recorded for promotional use without compensation.

Data Protection

35. Data is handled in accordance with the ticket provider's privacy policy.
 36. CCTV may be in operation at the Event.

General

37. The Organiser may update these Terms and Conditions where necessary. The latest version will be available on the website.
38. If any part of these Terms is found to be invalid, the remaining sections remain enforceable.
39. These Terms and Conditions are governed by English law.
